

Montana Healthcare Programs Drug Prior Authorization Coverage Criteria

Marinol™ (dronabinol)

Review Criteria

Member must meet all the following criteria for specific diagnosis:

- Diagnosis of malignant cancer in past 2 years
 - -with- antineoplastic/radiation therapy in the past 45 days
 - o -and- intolerance/failure on 5HT3 or NK-1 antagonist
 - -and- not currently receiving megesterol
- Diagnosis of cancer with diagnosis of cachexia or anorexia in past 2 years
 - -and- history of megesterol in the past 6 months BUT not currently receiving
- Diagnosis of HIV infection in the last 2 years
 - -with- diagnosis of cachexia or anorexia in past 2 years
 - o -and- not currently on megesterol

Limitations:

- Maximum daily dose of 20mg per day (except for short periods around chemotherapy schedule)
- Individual dose limits:
 - 2.5mg capsule maximum of 4 per day
 - 5mg capsule maximum of 4 per day
 - o 10mg capsule maximum of 2 per day
